OLD BUSINESS:

Baseball caps issue. Pat has digitized the MMVC patch. Steve will purchase some caps and have the design embroidered. Issue working.

Painting. Currently, Al (M37), Rich Galli (M38 touchup) and Steve Opp (M38A1) required post war paint. Bill (MB), Rich Morris (M100 trailer) and Rick Blackwood ((Power wagon) need early WWII paint. Len Thomas donated a spare tire mount, paint, camouflage netting, straps and rims (thanks Len!). Bruce has ordered/received the axle seals. Membership considering relocating to Tobe's. Fuel lines have been replaced and fuel tank appears sound/rust free. Members discussed about title, registration and insurance. Issue working.

Bruce and Rich M are coordinating a rifle shoot in Livingston, MT. Bruce states that the Match is on July 18 at the Park Co. rifle range. It will be a military and muzzle-loader match.
