OLD BUSINESS:

Baseball caps issue. Pat has digitized the MMVC patch. Steve will purchase some caps and have the design embroidered. Issue working.

Painting. Currently, Al (M37), Rich Galli (M38 touchup) and Steve Opp (M38A1) required post war paint. Bill (MB), Rich Morris (M100 trailer) and Rick Blackwood ((Power wagon) need early WWII paint. Steve will look for a windless 50 degree (plus) day in spring (or when available). Members need to have their vehicles prepared to paint by spring 2009. Antique aircraft posters. Bill Otto has framed them and they are great. We will take them to the Helena Air Show. Len Thomas will look into selling on E-Bay. Issue working.

Members discussed assembling a MMVC Club BBQ Grill out of Jeep Parts. Good project for winter. Parts are being assembled. Issue working.

Members discussed going to the “running of the sheep” in Reedpoint, MT. Al has made calls and is still waiting for someone to return his calls. Issue working.

M43 Ambulance (“the Money Pit”) update.

Members voted to paint the vehicle OD (Membership approved). Bruce has ordered and received the new wheel cylinders.

Membership discussed what to do next and decided to purchase Battery cables and batteries (Dana is pricing them at NAPA). Steve Opp couldn’t find an air cleaner for the “Pit”. May need some new brake lines. Members discussed bringing fuel tank to Billings for cleaning/repair. Len Thomas donated a spare tire mount, paint, camouflage netting, straps and rims (thanks Len!). Bruce has ordered/received the Air Cleaner. Issue working.

Bruce and Rich M are coordinating a rifle shoot in Livingston, MT. Bruce states that the Match is on July 18 at the Park Co. rifle range. It will be a military and muzzle-loader match. We will shoot U.S. military rifles in the morning starting at 9A.M. and will shoot TRADITIONAL muzzle loaders in the afternoon. The course of fire for the cartridge guns will be 8 shots at 100 yds from the prone, sitting, and standing at paper targets and scored as an aggregate. The muzzle-loaders will shoot at 75 and 100 yds? Details of that to have to be worked out. Bruce wanted to get this out early enough as the range changed the date for calendar info but didn’t tell anyone so the match will not appear on their printed calendar.
